Each year NEWH gives out its most prestigious award; the Icon of Industry, at the Gold Key Awards Breakfast in New York City held in conjunction with the International Hotel/Motel & Restaurant Show in November and then again at the Platinum Circle Gala during HD Expo and Conference in May. The award celebrates the leaders of the manufacturing side of hospitality, those who have uniquely impacted the industry through their innovative work. They consistently dedicated their time and efforts to community or industry outreach through education and/or corporate giving, and have been doing business in hospitality for more than 30 years. In addition, each year an international scholarship is given to two exemplary students in the recipient's honor, who have completed at least half of their program toward a degree in the hospitality industry, have a minimum 3.0 GPA, participated in an industry internship, and exemplify the highest standards of professionalism and scholarship.



Each year NEWH awards its ICON of Industry to a manufacturer who is a true leader in the Hospitality Industry. The recipient is to have the following qualities: have made significant impact in the industry through innovation; have dedicated themselves and their companies to their communities and the Hospitality Industry through outreach, mentoring and education and have had a minimum of thirty years in the Hospitality Industry.

This year is the seventh year for the ICON of Industry Award and NEWH is very proud to honor Harvey Nudelman with this award. Harvey has been in the fabric industry for over 40 years. He founded Fabricut Contract in 1969, eleven years later with the purchase of Lazarus Fabrics, Fabricut strengthened its position as being a leader in the Hospitality Industry. Harvey has always aimed to set his company apart from others in the industry. In 2007, he introduced FR-One Fabrics which passes and exceeds all fire-retardant and safety standards worldwide. With this and the many fabric collections that Fabricut offers they have become and will remain one of the most innovative fabric companies in the Hospitality Industry.

Outside of our industry, Harvey spends much of his free time supporting the American Cancer Society where he serves as a board member of the Nevada Chapter. As a two time lung cancer survivor he is committed to helping others cope with this disease. He has spent time with many survivors or those that are fighting the disease providing encouragement and support as they move forward with the challenges of this disease.

NEWH has been blessed with Harvey's commitment to our organization both internationally and on a local chapter level. Fabricut has been a NEWH Corporate Partner since 2004. In addition they sponsor the annual FR-One, a \$3,000.00 scholarship that is awarded at the Platinum Circle event in Las Vegas. He was also instrumental, several years ago, in helping start NEWH's School from the Heart campaign which raised money for UNICEF. Harvey has been and continues to remain very involved with his local chapter in Las Vegas as well as encouraging his sales team to be involved with their local NEWH chapters.

HARVEY NUDELMAN serves as president of Fabricut Inc. and oversees the daily operations and sales for its hospitality divisions Fabricut Contract and S. Harris Contract – premier textile distributors for the hospitality industry. Harvey has been an influential leader in the textile and hospitality industries for 50 years.

Harvey began his textile career in Chicago in 1961 as a salesman for Tempo Fabrics and later the owner of Westport Fabrics in Kansas City. In 1968, he joined Fabricut Inc. as vice president of sales and the following year launched its hospitality division, Fabricut Contract; Harvey was then promoted to

president of Fabricut Inc. in 1978. He helped with the purchase of Lazarus Fabrics in 1980 to further Fabricut Contract's place and product offering in the hospitality industry; not long after, S. Harris Contract launched.

Throughout his 42 years with Fabricut Inc., Harvey has served as a mentor to many current industry leaders and associates. Whether their careers began with Harvey or his friendship and guidance instilled the confidence needed to succeed, they have become major contributors within the hospitality industry.

Harvey's devotion to industry innovations was instrumental in the collaboration with FR-One[®] to bring its brand and products to the United States in 2007—textiles that pass and exceed all fire-retardant and safety standards worldwide. Harvey continues to push Fabricut Contract to provide solutions to everyday specifications and an extensive offering that assures fabrics are in style, in code and in budget.

He has been an active member of NEWH since its inception as a corporate sponsor, scholarship advocate and contributor, and founders meeting attendee. Harvey also helped jump start NEWH's School from the Heart campaign to raise money for UNICEF's School-in-a-Box program.


I believe in the power of knowledge and the value of education. As a result my primary goal after graduation has always been pursuing a Master's Degree; in particular one which will compliment and enhance my background in Interior Design. The most desirable choice for me is a Master's of Business Administration. Seeing as a Bachelor's Degree is required to pursue a Master's, I enrolled in the Interior Design program at Kwantlen Polytechnic University in September 2010. I was placed in the third year of a four year CIDA accredited program. Coming to Kwantlen has been one of the greatest academic decisions I have ever made. The program is fast-paced and demanding and their conceptual approach to design unleashes your creativity and reinforces your understanding of design principles. During third year I designed a retail store, an office, a restaurant and a wellness centre with two other classmates. After completing the office design project I was nominated for the Steelcase Award for Design Excellence. Two classmates and I presented to the Steelcase representatives and a winner was elected. Although I did not win it was an outstanding opportunity which validated my hard work (and sleepless nights) and my sense of design. During third year I also participated in a one-week internship at SSDG Interiors, Inc. SSDG Interiors is an award-winning firm specializing in hospitality and commercial interior design. I had a fulfilling and productive week and I feel fortunate to say that I was asked to remain part-time as a junior designer ever since then. My experience at SSDG Interiors has been invaluable, allowing me to expand upon my personal and professional growth as stated in the following essay. During my final year I have chosen to design a venue where

intimate musical performances can be enjoyed. The venue will include a recording studio along with a restaurant and bar. I am thrilled to take such a distinct project on and apply everything I have learned through my schooling and my work experiences.

I have learned a lot in my past year at Kwantlen and I feel that I have made a contribution to my university and to my fellow students. My work has been displayed on many occasions (including during architect Raymond Moriyama's visit and speech at Kwantlen) and some has been shown to the representatives of CIDA. "Are you my daddy?" was the question I asked most often as I was growing up in Rangoon, Burma. For as long as I could speak Burmese, I posed that question to every man who came into my grandparent's auto shop. My father had been forced to flee the country for his life, leaving his family behind when I was only six months old. When I was eight years old our family was finally reunited in the United States.

As a newcomer in elementary school, I worked hard to learn English and get to know my teachers. In middle school, I was accepted into the junior honors society and won the yearbook contest. I was a busy bee in high school as the president for Habitat for Humanity, officer of the Honors Society, morning announcer, a rower, and part-time worker.

In 2005, my hard work finally paid off when I was accepted to the number one Hotel Management program in the world at Cornell University. As a first year college student, I worked at the Statler Hotel at Cornell, in both the front and back of house, to gain knowledge of a hotel's layout and flow of space. In the summer of my sophomore year I was fortunate enough to be the LEED project leader for existing buildings at Le Parker Meridien (LPM) in New York City. Working as an intern at LPM gave me the leverage to fine-tune my leadership skills through working side by side with their management team.

The summer after my junior year was thrilling for me, when I worked as an assistant to the Design Director of Elite Concepts in Hong Kong. Interning for Elite Concepts allowed me to develop my knowledge in the design of international restaurants and gave me the opportunity to develop my communication skills with people from all around the world.

During my senior year, I was chosen to be the Design Director for the 84th Hotel Ezra Cornell (HEC) at the Hotel School. As Design Director I was challenged with creating and leading a team of ten talented designers responsible for developing and implementing the design concept for 12 food and beverage functions for the Hotel Schools alumni and leader in the hospitality industry. I worked closely with Dean Johnson, his staff, and the Statler Hotel to create a program, contact vendors, and assemble a guest list. I spent many hours with the Food and Beverage Director going over menus, floor layouts, uniforms, and the overall budget for the events. At the end of my term as Design Director, I had learned not only about the practicalities and complexities of event planning, but also that I was capable of becoming an inspirational leader and communicator.

Having knowledge of hotel management, leadership, and communication skills acquired at Cornell, I enrolled at the Savannah College of Art and Design (SCAD) to study at one of the top, nationally ranked interior design programs, with the interest of concentrating in hospitality design. At SCAD, I became assimilated to a new culture and embraced every class, from five-hour studios to lecture classes on materials, environmental systems, theory and criticism, and others - excelling in my classes. Most importantly, through my studies at SCAD I have learned to convey my ideas in a more refined manner through visual language, process sketches and conceptual diagrams, and now understand the value of a well thought out design.

I have noticed a trend of expansion of tourism in the East, Pacific, and South Asia regions. Considering my dream of contributing to Burma's economy through tourism, my thesis topic focuses on how interior designers can design flexible spaces for both public and private areas in the hotel that cater to the needs of Asian business and leisure travelers. The intended outcome for the thesis project is to create an environment utilizing technology and sensory-based design to ensure that travelers always feel comfortable in their surroundings.
