Tour of the Slate Hotel

LOCATION: 1250 WELTON ST, DENVER, CO 80204

BrandED took us on a tour of <u>The Slate Denver, Tapestry Collection by</u> <u>Hilton</u>. The four-story, 135,000-square-foot property, opened on May 24, 2022, in downtown Denver, once housed the Emily Griffith Opportunity School, which provided vocational opportunities to people of all different ages and backgrounds.

This school building, turned designated landmark, turned Hilton hotel was designed in part to be reminiscent of its educational roots. Symbolic features range from the typewriter artwork and school-themed meeting rooms and restaurant and bar, to the still remaining original staircase and hallways from the school's era. - 2 Medium Shallots chopped
- 4 Cloves Garlic mashed
- 2 Carrots chopped into coins
- 2 Celery Stalks diced
- 315 Dunce Cans Cannellini Beans drained and rinsed
- 2 Bay Leaves
- 1 Tablespoon Italian Seasoning
- 1/2 Teaspoon Ded Pepper Flakes
- 5-6 Cups Vegetable Broth
- 1/2 Teaspoon Sea Salt
- 1/4 Teaspoon Ground Black Pepper
- 3 Cups Fresh Spinach
