



FLOOR PLAN



REFLECTING THE EAST VILLAGE NEIGHBORHOOD LOCATED IN TULSA, OKLAHOMA, THIS MICRO—APARTMENT ENCOMPASSES THE SURROUNDING INDUSTRIAL MODERN BUILDING MATERIALS WITH HINTS OF ART DECO THROUGH ITS MATERIAL SELECTION AND THE USE OF PATTERNS AND LINES. TO SUPPORT TULSA'S WEALTH OF ART DECO, ONE FINDS METALLIC ACCENTS AND GEOMETRIC SHAPES APPLIED THROUGHOUT THE SPACE. AS TULSA POSSESSES A RICH HISTORY FOR EXPERIENCING MANY INDUSTRIAL INNOVATIONS IN THE OIL FIELD, METAL FINISHES ARE APPLIED ON WINDOWS, DOORS, AND WALL DIVIDERS TO REFLECT THIS. COLORS IN THE FAMILY OF GREENS, BLUES, AND GOLDS, CAN BE SEEN IN TILE, CABINET COLORS, AND TEXTILES TO REFLECT THE OKLAHOMA FLAG. A COWMFORTABLE AND PRODUCTIVE ATMOSPHERE IS EXHIBITED THROUGH OPEN, FLOWING SPACES THROUGH A MARRIAGE OF INDUSTRIAL MATERIALS AND THE ART DECO STYLE. THIS MICRO—APARTMENT OFFERS A BLEND OF MULTI—FUNCTIONAL, BUILT—IN AND FREE—STANDING FURNITURE THAT PROVIDES ROOM FOR PERSONALIZATION, THUS ELIMINATING THE STRESS OF BRINGING AND ARRANGING FURNITURE INTO THE SPACE. TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE TULSA REMOTE PROGRAM IN THIS DILIGENTLY ARRANGED SPACE THAT UTILIZES NATURAL LIGHT AND VERTICAL VOLUME TO ENLARGE THE SPACE. ON THE INTERIOR, MATERIALS THAT SUPPORT THE BLEND OF ART DECO AND INDUSTRIAL MODERN DESIGN INCLUDE BRICK, EUCALYPTUS FLOORING, WOOL CARPET. WALL TILES, VETRAZZO COUNTERTOPS, AND QUARTZ. ON THE PRIMARY FLOOR, REMOTE WORKERS WILL NOTICE A SUSTAINABLE ALTERNATIVE TO WOOD, EUCALYPTUS. THIS MATERIAL IS AS DURABLE AS HARDWOOD AND BY REMOVING THIS INVASIVE SPECIES FROM ITS HOME, THE ENVIRONMENT EXPERIENCES BENEFITS. IT PROVIDES MOISTURE-RESISTANT FLOORING THAT IS DURABLE AND EASY TO CLEAN. ON THE STAIRS AND BEDROOM LOFT, ONE FINDS WOOL CARPET ON THE FLOORING TO ADD WARMTH TO THIS COZY RESTING AREA. THIS SELECTED CARPET IS NOT TREATED WITH HARMFUL CHEMICALS AND SUPPORTS THE PURIFICATION OF INDOOR AIR QUALITY. SHIFTING TO THE WALL MATERIALS, ONE NOTICES AN EXTERIOR BRICK ACCENT WALL PAIRED WITH INDUSTRIAL-STYLED WINDOWS. THESE BRICK WALL PAVERS ARE EASY AND ECONOMICAL TO INSTALL AS THEY ARE INTERLOCKING, LIGHTWEIGHT, DURABLE, AND DO NOT REQUIRE ANY ADDITIONAL SUPPORT. TO COMPLEMENT THE BRICK TEXTURE, THE REMAINING WALLS ARE FINISHED WITH A SATIN LIGHT GRAY PAINT TO PROVIDE A NEUTRAL BACKGROUND AGAINST ACTIVE COLORS AND PATTERNS TO DISPLAY ANY PERSONALIZATION BROUGHT BY THE USERS. AN INFUSION OF COLOR AND INTEREST IS PRIMARILY BROUGHT IN THROUGH THE TILE SELECTION. THESE TILES ARE SELECTED FROM DALTILE, WHOSE MAIN MISSION IS TO SUPPORT SUSTAINABILITY AND THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT. OVER 99% OF THEIR TILE IS RECYCLED MATERIALS AND MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR LEED CREDITS. THESE PRODUCTS CONTAIN NO VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUNDS. THE FINAL PRIMARY ARCHITECTURAL MATERIAL IS FOUND IN THE COUNTERTOPS. THE BATHROOM COUNTERTOP IS SOURCED FROM VETRAZZO, WHICH IS COMPRISED OF HANDCRAFTED, AMERICAN-MADE PRODUCTS THAT ARE CONSTRUCTED WITH CONCRETE AND RECYCLED GLASS. IN THE KITCHEN, THIS QUARTZ COUNTERTOP IS SOURCED FROM GRENITE. THIS COMPANY PROVIDES A DURABLE COUNTERTOP THAT IS MANUFACTURED WITH 80% RECYCLED CONTENT, CONTRIBUTING TO LOWER INSTALLATION COSTS. THESE SUSTAINABLE MATERIALS AND FINISH SELECTIONS COME TOGETHER TO CREATE A SPACE THAT ENCOURAGES PERSONALIZATION, PRODUCTIVITY, AND RELAXATION THROUGH ITS MULTI-FUNCTIONAL DESIGNS AND UNIQUE TILE SELECTIONS. THE JEWEL TONES, GEOMETRIC LINES, AND METALLIC ACCENTS HIGHLIGHT TULSA AS ONE OF THE LARGEST ART DECO CENTERS OF THE COUNTRY WHILE CONTRIBUTING TO THE UP-AND-COMING INDUSTRIAL MODERN EAST VILLAGE DISTRICT OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA BUILT FROM ITS HISTORY OF INDUSTRIAL INNOVATIONS.

"A racing painting is not just the horses. There is so much — the colors, the characters, the racegoers, the bookies, the architecture. There is such a narrative possibility."













Adjacency Matrix


ENJOY THE SPACE.

THE DESIGN OF THIS ROWHOUSE CONTRIBUTES TO THE EXTERIOR VICTORIAN ARCHITECTURE FOUND IN LOGAN CIRCLE. USING CHARLES EAMESUMETHOD OF DESIGN, THESE SPACES USE FUNCTION AS MOTIVATION. FROM THE CREATIVE USE OF NOOKS AND BUILT-INS, PROVISION OF NEEDS, ROOM ADJACENCY CONSIDERATIONS, AND PERSONALIZED WORKSPACES, THIS DESIGN PAYS ATTENTION TO THE DETAIL AND ENSURES THE SPACE IS FUNCTIONAL. VICTORIAN ARCHITECTURAL PRINCIPLES ARE SEEN THROUGH PATTERNED WALLPAPER, SENTIMENTAL PICTURES, DECORATIVE MOLDING AND WOODWORK, AND THE USERS ABILITY TO SHOWCASE THEIR PERSONAL WEALTH AND TASTE. AMPLE AND FLEXIBLE ENTERTAINMENT SPACES WILL FLOW ACROSS MULTIPLE ROOMS AND HIGHLIGHT THE UNIQUE ARCHITECTURAL FEATURES SUCH AS THE BAY WINDOWS AND STAIRS. THIS DESIGN FINDS MODERN WAYS TO REINTERPRET HISTORIC DESIGN BY EXPANDING UPON A SMALL VICTORIAN ELEMENT THROUGH COLOR, TEXTURE, AND MASS TO CREATE FOCAL POINTS WHILE SEAMLESSLY BLENDING IN MODERN PRACTICES THROUGH NEUTRAL COLORS AND SMOOTH LINES. THIS DESIGN CONSIDERS EACH HOBBY AND INTEREST OF THE USERS AND THOUGHTFULLY INCORPORATES THEM INTO THE SPACE. 




RENDERED FLOOR PLAN SCALE: N.T.S.


