LISA VILLARREAL FOUNDER & CEO LILY JACK

isa Villarreal is the founder and owner of Lily Jack, a third-generation fine furniture manufacturing company, specializing in custom seating, metal and casegoods suited for the luxury high-end hospitality industry. With owned manufacturing facilities in the US and Mexico, as well as factory partners and offices in Vietnam and China, Lily Jack is a global supplier to many of the leading hotel brands in the world.

Lisa fell in love with furniture after spending time in her grandfather's importing business, learning how he designed and developed product for his clients with partner factories all over Europe. After his passing, she joined her mother to help continue the legacy Jack had created.



As a young entrepreneur, Lisa saw the potential to grow the family business, J.S. Greene Associates,

into something much bigger. In 1986 with the support of her mother Judy, they began working with local manufacturers to provide custom furniture to serve the needs of their growing clientele. Hospitality projects ensued, and the company continued to expand over the next decade as a private label manufacturer, leaning into hospitality exclusively. Named after her grandparents, Lily Jack made its debut in 2000 with their first in-line collection of furniture at HD Las Vegas.







In the last 22 years, Lisa has focused Lily Jack's efforts towards providing high quality furniture for the ever-changing and demanding needs of the hospitality industry. Her true passion is to collaborate and work with designers to ensure their vision is executed, while utilizing her experience to build products that perform in challenging hospitality environments. Obsessive about the details, Lisa trains her team to consider all factors when developing furnishings with interior designers and architects.



Lisa finds her greatest inspiration from her family. The love for her two

boys pushed her to never give up. Her grandfather taught her to always lead with integrity; a core pillar of Lily Jack's values. Beyond her family, Lisa is inspired by all things beautiful; nature, antiques, fashion, art, and photography.

Being able to give her employees opportunities and further their education has become a focus of Lisa's since opening her factory in Tijuana, Mexico in 2014. One example is a scholarship program in which team members can attend classes for English, finish high school, college, or graduate school. With an "A," the company reimburses 100% of their tuition. They currently have over 20 students that have gone through the program, something Lisa is incredibly proud of. Most recently, in early 2022, Lisa started an upholstery school in the Tijuana factory. This school is a way to give the employees an opportunity to gain experience and advance their careers.

After 34 years of producing furniture, Lisa can still be found working on the factory floor, collaborating with the craftsmen that make Lily Jack furniture one of the most recognizable in the industry.

FARZANE OMIDI \$7,500 NEWH ICON OF INDUSTRY SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

Before coming to the United States, I received my bachelor's and master's degrees in architecture in my home country Iran. Now I am an interior design graduate student at Texas Tech University. During my education, I was always focused on hospitality and healthcare design and believe the two fields have many overlaps. Specifically, my ideas about the hospitality sector are outside the box, and I believe there are many potential opportunities to explore and many outcomes to the society when looking at these two sectors simultaneously. Examples include providing travel accommodations for seniors, medical tourism, or increasing hotel users' health and wellbeing through sustainable design.

Recently, I worked on developing sustainable designs in the hospitality industry that I presented at the 2022 annual IDEC conference. My current work addresses needs identified in both the hospitality and healthcare sectors in light of the recent pandemic. Specifically, I am exploring solutions that can help address the economic uncertainty that the hospitality sector will face during potential future disasters. The project focuses on designing multipurpose hotels that can serve multiple functions. The first step in expanding this research will be presenting it at the annual HCD conference in October, where I hope to network with reps from the healthcare industry and encourage them to connect with hospitality heads. Then, I will move forward with the steps necessary for funding. Presenting at this conference, which is the largest in this particular field of design, also offers me the opportunity to represent Texas Tech and showcase the quality of the research and instruction provided at our institution. I have also conducted research in partnership with undergraduate students from the school of design that addressed living conditions in senior care facilities. This was a paid opportunity for the students, and I was able to volunteer and assume a leadership role in which I mentored the development of the project and helped prepare it for submission to the National Science Foundation (NSF) Program and TTU Innovation Hub, through which we will pursue a patent.

Once I graduate, I want to go to a firm that is open to the idea of working on hospitality designs in conjunction with healthcare to address the health and well-being of society overall. When I look for a firm to work for, a willingness to embrace these types of projects will be one of the main criteria I rely on to make my final decision.

As an international student, I cannot work more than twenty hours each week, and it does not cover my expenses. This scholarship would help with this shortage, and I will have a calmer mind to concentrate on getting additional certificates like NCIDQ and LEED GA. These certificates will guarantee my future career and will give me more options in selecting the company that aligns with my specific interest.

ow, you sure do look familiar," she said in her Mississippi manner, staring curiously into my face and searching my features for a crumb of recognition. Looking at me, my grandmother might as well have been looking in a mirror, but I was one of many things, people, places, events, and processes she had long forgotten.

My grandmother's name was Georgia, but everyone called her Madea - like the Tyler Perry character. She was loving, kind-hearted, and generous. Regrettably, I watched dementia close the door to Madea's mind. I did not know whether to laugh or cry when at my mother's wedding she sincerely looked into my eyes and asked why I was so familiar. As a family, we did not have the knowledge or resources to help her in the ways she needed help. What's more, because of her illness, her experience in her home was one in which she was confused, uncomfortable, and unsafe. I became afraid of ALZ, but what began as anxiety about a disease I did not understand, developed into a passion for advocacy and a desire to create aspirational interior design.

As I progressed in my profession, it became clear that my interests did not rest in residential work. I needed to go beyond aesthetics and wanted to touch more people with my designs. I learned that I am passionate about the impact of the interior environment on user outcomes, employee wellness, and facility functionality but, as a Healthcare Design graduate student at Kent State University, I have developed a specific interest in the challenges associated with designing environments for aging adults and recently added a Gerontology certificate to my studies. Thus, my objective has evolved to enhance the experience of patients in the spaces where they are most vulnerable and receive care.

This fall, my graduate project will focus on challenges associated with designing for aging adults, including those who experience cognitive functional decline due to dementia. The World Health Organization has labeled dementia a public health priority and established an initiative to create dementia-supportive societies capable of shouldering the demands of this priority. This initiative aligns with my graduate project and career objective. I believe healthcare facilities and residential spaces of care can, and will, meet these demands.

Currently, I am interning at a small medical interiors firm where I am able to contribute senior-focused concepts to designs. After graduation, I would like to continue my graduate research subject as a healthcare design fellow at a firm that specializes in senior environments. In the future, I will open a healthcare facilities and senior living design firm and create a non-profit organization to support a home healthcare model that will provide acute care for seniors from the comfort of their homes.

I realize history gives us insight that helps us discover innovative solutions. In obtaining this scholarship, I am closer to becoming a healthcare designer inspired by my family to design patient-centered environments which will enhance healing practices for entire healthcare communities.


