The NEWH Scholarship Programme	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Alongside free attendance at some of the NEWH events, students also have the chance to apply for scholarship funding. Each year, NEWH awards at least three Scholarships to Undergraduate students in their 2nd year (and above) or Master's students, studying Interior Design, Spatial and Environment Design, Architecture, or Hotel Management.</li> <li>* Interested students from Universities around the UK are invited to submit their applications. Then a shortlist of ten students will be invited to attend a presentation day in July in a London showroom.</li> <li>* These ten students will be asked to present their work to an esteemed panel of design professionals, including the scholarship director for NEWH UK.</li> <li>* At the end of the day, up to three students are selected and will each receive;             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A scholarship fund of £2000</li> <li>- One year courtesy associate membership upon graduation</li> <li>- Exposure to the hospitality industry through networking events and various publications</li> <li>- Access to placement opportunities, should these arise</li> </ul> </li> <li>* In late September, in a centrally located London hotel, NEWH UK will host their Annual Fundraiser where we celebrate and award the NEWH scholarships to the successful students.</li> </ul>
This year's Scholarship Competition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* On receipt of your NEWH Scholarship application, you will receive an email within 3 weeks stating if your application has been successful. If you are one of the ten shortlisted students, you will be invited to take part in the competition at the NEWH scholarship presentation day.</li> <li>* All applicants will be asked to produce a concept design for a single hotel space, such as reception, guestroom, or restaurant. A full project brief will be sent to all ten students at the same time, and you will then have at least 3 weeks to work on your design.</li> <li>* On the presentation day, each student will be given 10 minutes to present their concept, followed by 10 minutes of questions by the judges.</li> <li>* Presentations are to judges only, (not in front of other students), and they are informal and fun. No Dragons Den here!</li> <li>* Student projects should be presented on a <b>maximum of 2 No. A1 boards in portrait format</b>. There are to be NO digital presentations (no laptops, tablets, AI headsets projectors etc.). Students can also bring along a small amount of supporting sketch books, models &amp; material samples if they wish to do so.</li> <li>* Each student can choose to do some or all the following, to help present their concept &amp; ideas: Plans, elevations, material boards, inspirational images, flow diagrams, sketches, mood boards, models and/or visuals.</li> <li>* The project can be developed &amp; presented however best explains the concept. Therefore, it can be done in any format or program - CAD, hand sketching, photoshop, 3D programmes, collages etc. We encourage sharing any side sketch studies, materials, working models, inspirational images or narrative that supports the design.</li> <li>* It is completely up to each student how much they choose to do for this competition. All students will receive this brief at the same time. We appreciate that everyone has different commitments, resources, experience, and abilities. These will all be considered during the presentation review.</li> <li>* It is very important for all students to be aware that this competition <b>is not</b> judged on the ability of students to use advanced computer programs, special graphics, or perfect presentation skills. It is about the student's ability to understand and reflect on the given brief; their ability to form their own narrative and share how this drives their design approach, both in aesthetics and functionality. It is not necessarily about producing a fully completed design in the 3 weeks, but sharing an exciting start to an amazing concept.</li> <li>* The day will end with a very informal Q&amp;A session, when students will have the opportunity to ask the judges about their experience &amp; advice and to network with the other students.</li> </ul>

Criteria	<p>* <b>You must be actively enrolled as a student, attending university in The United Kingdom of Great Britain</b>, studying a Degree Course (in your second year or above and in continuous study until the end of 2024), or a graduate starting a Masters's course until the end of 2024. Evidence of enrolment in continuous study and pass grades for university course to present date are required as part of the application.</p> <p>* You must have a financial need for university tuition fee's (past, current and /or upcoming) and/or for course approved books, supplies, University trips, university workshop or equipment hire time. Career objective within a hospitality related field (Interior Design, Architecture, Environmental or Spatial Design etc.)</p> <p>* You must be available to attend the NEWH presentation day (Date still to be confirmed).</p> <p>* You must be available to attend the NEWH Fundraiser in September, in a centrally located London Hotel. (Date still to be confirmed)</p>
