- 3.0 GPA (cumulative) or overall "B" average or grade percentage of 83% 86% equivalent.
- Financial need through college for past/current/upcoming tuition or program approved books/supplies.
- Program in construction, electricity, pipe trades, plumbing, HVAC, etc., interested in building, renovating, or maintaining various types of properties in the hospitality industry.

Include with your application:

Official Transcript: We understand that sometimes transcripts and letter(s) may need to be sent in separately per
college policy.
Course description, including location and cost of the program enrolled in.
Up to 3 letters of recommendation (example from professor, advisor, employer, etc.)
Student essay (500-word maximum) to include:

- Background of yourself and your experience
- Your goals and objectives after graduation
- What factors influenced you to pursue a career in the building trades?
- Why is obtaining this scholarship important to you?
- If your application is not accepted, what plans do you have for financing?

NEWH Scholarship FAQ's

Criteria:

- College/program accreditation: we do not stipulate who the college/program must be accredited by it just needs to be accredited.
- First year graduate students may apply.
- Only official transcripts are accepted; do not send <u>unofficial</u>. Mail or email official transcript.
- Letters of recommendation/reference can be submitted by mail and/or email.
- Student essay 500-word maximum; follow the requirement-do not go over.
- Preference will be given to candidates who write original responses without using an AI tool.

Submission:

- We prefer you to collect all items (essay, transcript, letters) and combine into (1) PDF document and mail or email your submission to newh.scholarship@newh.org
- We understand sometimes transcripts/letters need to be sent in separately.

Selection:

- Scholarships are awarded based on NEWH scholarship criteria: selected major and career selection, debt through college, GPA, student background and references.
- Applicants must have submitted all necessary requirements with their application to qualify.

Notification:

 All applicants will receive an email stating their application status within 30-60 days of the scholarship deadline date

Award:

Awarded funds are made payable to the student's college and mailed directly to the college. Funds are never payable to a student. Unused funds are returned to NEWH. Awarded funds may only be applied toward tuition or program approved books/supplies (past, current or upcoming expenses). Awarded funds cannot be used for anything else (housing, personal needs, etc.).
